The University of Surrey was established in 1966 but its roots stretch back to a late nineteenth-century mission to provide access to higher education for the poorer inhabitants of London.

The university is a global community in a vibrant campus setting, dedicated to high-impact education and research. The University of Surrey actively pursues international engagement through a network of mutually beneficial partnerships all over the world, which provides students with international experiences and opportunities to enhance their employability prospects. 95% of graduates, and 94% of international graduates, are in employment or further study 18 months after graduating. This figure rises to an impressive 98% for those graduates who took a placement whilst at Surrey (Graduate Outcomes 2024, HESA).
