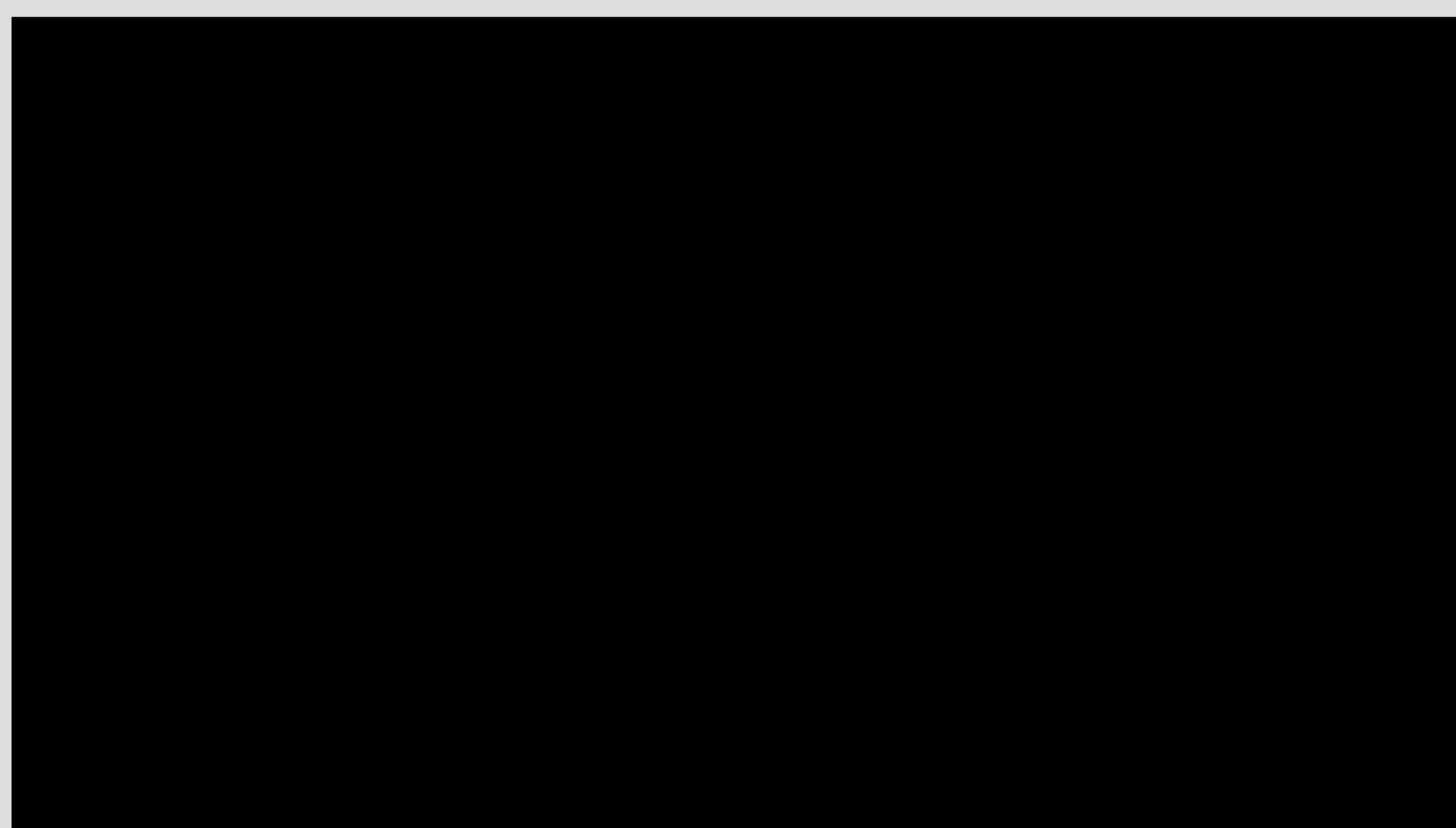
Learn from Industry Insiders
