**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
FOR ACADEMIC COOPERATION
BETWEEN
DEPARTMENT OF NURSING, COLLEGE OF MEDICINE
NATIONAL CHENG KUNG UNIVERSITY, TAIWAN

DEPARTMENT OF NURSING AND DEPARTMENT OF MIDWIFERY
FACULTY OF MEDICINE, UNIVERSITAS NEGERI MALANG, INDONESIA**

This Memorandum of Agreement (“MOA”) for international cooperation in education, research and community services is entered into by and between the Department of Nursing, College of Medicine, National Cheng Kung University, Taiwan and Department of Nursing and Department of Midwifery Faculty of Medicine, Universitas Negeri Malang, Indonesia (hereinafter referred to individually as a “party” and collectively as the “parties”).

In this MOA, “home institution” shall mean the institution at which the student intends to graduate, and “host institution” shall mean the institution that has agreed to accept the student from the home institution.

BACKGROUND

WHEREAS, the parties believe that it is in their best interests to encourage direct contact and cooperation among their faculty members, departments, institutes, and other research centers in fields of education and research to be agreed upon and subject to the availability of funding and to the development of specific binding agreements;

WHEREAS, within the fields of study to be mutually designated, both parties desire to discuss and explore the general forms of cooperation set forth below; and

WHEREAS, in order to carry out such discussions and explorations, the parties desire to set forth a framework in which such interaction may occur.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree to enter into this MOA for the purpose of setting forth their understanding and agreement with respect to the potential establishment and operation of cooperative programs.

1. Purpose of MOA

Both parties agree to encourage the following activities to promote international academic cooperation:

- a. Exchange of information in education and research field of interest to both parties;
- b. Exchange of invitations to scholars for lectures, talks, and sharing of experience;
- c. Exchange of students to broaden their horizon with international experience;
- d. Exchange of teaching staffs to initiate joint research depending on the specialty;
- e. Join education, research activities, publications and library exchange; and

- f. Joint community service,
- g. Support postgraduate students to develop high quality applications to National Cheng Kung University postgraduate taught (Master Level) and research (PhD) programs.

This MOA shall be applicable for education and research organization attached to each party. Before the implementation of these activities, both parties shall discuss the related issues for the satisfaction of each party and enter into specific activity agreements on terms and conditions mutually agreed upon.

2. Term and Renewal

This MOA shall become effective as of the date of signature by representatives of both parties. Any amendment or termination of this MOA shall not be effective unless made with the mutual written consent of both parties. In the event of any discrepancy in interpretation between different language versions, the English version shall prevail. This MOA may be reviewed every five (5) years to evaluate progress and to improve quality of the cooperation.

3. Financial Matters

Based on this MOA, both parties recognize that financial provisions for the collaborative program is limited, each party shall endeavor to provide support in the following matters:

- a. **Faculty and Staff Exchanges:** It is understood that the details of joint activities, the conditions for the utilization of the results achieved, as well as arrangements for specific visits, exchanges, and other forms of cooperation, shall be determined on a case-by-case basis. Financial arrangements shall be negotiated separately for each activity and shall be subject to the availability of funds. The number of staff exchanges shall be mutually agreed upon prior to the commencement of each activity.
- b. **Student Exchanges:** The students will be required to cover all their expenses on their own, and the host institution will only provide teaching activities. The home institution will assist in doing the administrative work and provide funding information to the students participating in the exchanges. The number and duration of student exchange shall be mutually agreed prior to commencement of this activity. All students will be required to purchase adequate health insurance and/or accident insurance at their own expense for the exchange period. The study plan for the visit shall be mutually agreed upon by both parties.

4. Anti-Discrimination

Both parties will sign to the policy of equal opportunity and avoid any discrimination on the basis of race, age, ethnicity, religion or nation origin. Department of Nursing, College of Medicine, National Cheng Kung University and Department of Nursing and Department of Midwifery Faculty of Medicine, Universitas Negeri Malang, Indonesia, shall abide by these principles in the administration of this MOA.

5. Nonbinding Terms

This MOA shall not be deemed to be a binding agreement and shall not be enforceable in any court or tribunal for any purpose.
