1. **Ro'ufah Inayati, S.Pd., M.Pd:** Head of Bachelor of Economic Education Study Program, whom therefore legally represents and acts for and on behalf of Head of Bachelor of Economic Education Study Program, Faculty of Economics and Business, Universitas Negeri Malang, whose address is at Jalan Semarang 5, Malang, hereinafter referred to as **Party I**.
2. **Dra. Mimin Mintarsih:** Head of Sanggar Bimbingan Sungai Mulia (SBSM) 5 Gombak, Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia whom therefore legally represents and acts for and on behalf of Sanggar Bimbingan Sungai Mulia (SBSM) 5 Gombak, Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, whose address is at Sanggar Bimbingan Sungai Mulia 5, 50, Lorong Sungai Mulia 5, Kampung Sungai Mulia, 53000 Kuala Lumpur, Federal Territory of Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, hereinafter referred to as **Party II**.

PARTY I and **PARTY II** hereinafter referred to collectively as **THE PARTIES**. The Parties hereby agree to jointly arrange an Implementation Agreement on the community service program Organized by **THE PARTIES** as regulated in the following articles.

Article 1

PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES

- (1) The purpose of this Implementation Agreement is to serve as the basis for the Implementation Agreement arranged by **THE PARTIES** in accordance with the scope of this Implementation Agreement Regulation.
- (2) The objective of this Implementation Agreement is to support the activities of **THE PARTIES** in relation to cooperation with regard to the community service program

Article 2
SCOPE OF ACTIVITIES

- (1) The Scope of this agreement includes the International Community Service Program with the topic “LITTLE HANDS, BIG PLANS: TEACHING STUDENT THE POWER OF MONEY AND SMART SAVING AT SANGGAR BIMBINGAN SUNGAI MULIA KUALA LUMPUR, MALAYSIA, conducted by Sri Handayani, S.Pd., M.Pd., Ph.D., Ro’ufah Inayati, S.Pd., M.Pd., Dr. Farida Rahmawati, S.E., M.E.
- (2) **THE PARTIES** shall monitor the implementation of International Community Service Program program not less than 2 (two) times in one period of activity.

Article 3
FUNDING

Funding for this International Community Service Program covered by second party in amount RM 4800 or Rp. 18.700.000.

Article 4
DURATION

This Implementation Agreement of cooperation is valid from 16th May 2025 until 16th May 2026

Article 5
CLOSING

- (1) Any amendment to this Implementation Agreement shall only be made with the mutual approval of **THE PARTIES**.
- (2) This Implementation Agreement is deemed to be terminated if one **PARTY** or **THE PARTIES** fail to fulfill the provisions in this Implementation Agreement.
- (3) Particulars that are not / yet to be determined in this Implementation Agreement shall be addressed further by **THE PARTIES** on the basis of mutual discussion and agreement which shall be set forth in an Addendum, which is an integral part of this Implementation Agreement.
- (4) This document of Implementation Agreement is made and signed by **THE PARTIES** in 2 (two) copies, all of which shall constitute the equal legal force.

Article 6
Force Majeure

- (1) In the event of force majeure, including natural disasters, fires, security disturbances and other matters that result in the **PARTIES** being

unable to carry out the obligations as referred to in ARTICLE 3, the losses suffered by the PARTIES shall be borne by the **PARTIES** and **the PARTIES** shall be released from claims for the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding including claims for losses arising from this force majeure.

- (2) The circumstances as referred to in paragraph (1) must have a direct causal relationship with the losses suffered by the **PARTIES** and be proven by a Certificate from an Authorized Official no later than 30 (thirty) working days from the occurrence of the event as referred to in paragraph (1).
