



## MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

The Memorandum of Agreement (MoA), hereinafter referred to as "Agreement" has been made and entered into effect by and between:

- I. University of the Immaculate Conception – College of Human Environmental Sciences and Food Studies**, a private university located at Father Selga St., Davao City PHILIPPINES 8000 herein represented by **Dr. Nelca Stephany U. Amatong, RND** as a Dean of UIC College of Human Environmental Sciences and Food Studies, therefore she has a legitimate act for and on behalf of college, hereinafter referred to as "**FIRST PARTY**"; and
- II. Universitas Negeri Malang – Fakultas Ilmu Sosial**, a public university located at Jl. Cakrawala No.5, Sumber Sari, Kec. Lowokwaru, Kota Malang, Jawa Timur 65145, Indonesia, herein represented by **Prof. Dr. Ari Sapto, M.Hum**, as Dean of UM Fakultas Ilmu Sosial, therefore he has a legitimate act for and on behalf of therapy center, hereinafter referred to as "**SECOND PARTY**".

**FIRST PARTY** and **SECOND PARTY**, in this Agreement, are also individually referred to as **PARTY** or collectively as **PARTIES**.

Both **PARTIES** hereby agree to establish mutual cooperation in academic activities and to facilitate academic exchange.

On those bases, both **PARTIES** agree to make an Agreement in the framework of education, with the following provisions.

## **Article 1 OBJECTIVE**

The **PARTIES**, subject to the terms of this Agreement and the laws, rules, regulations and national policies from time to time in force in each party's country, will endeavor to strengthen, promote and develop academic and educational exchange between the **PARTIES** on the basis of equality and mutual benefit.

## **Article 2 AREAS OF CO-OPERATION**

- (1) Each **PARTY** will endeavor to take necessary steps to encourage and promote co-operation in the following areas:
  - a. Exchange of faculty members, administrative staffs, and or graduates for lecture purposes;
  - b. Skills training and development of undergraduate or graduate students;
  - c. Promotion of collaborative joint research and development projects;
  - d. Promotion of undergraduate students in research and development program;
  - e. Exchange of research outcomes, academic publications, and other academic information;
  - f. Collaboration in assisting undergraduate or graduate students on their Internship Training;
  - g. Other academic and educational exchange programs approved as suitable by both **PARTIES**.
- (2) The programs listed above are to be carried out after mutual consultation.
- (3) If necessary, details of specific programs under this Agreement will be set forth in the separate cooperation agreement and read as a part of this Agreement.

## **Article 3 ENTRY INTO EFFECT AND DURATION**

- (1) This Agreement shall come into force on the last date of signing and shall remain in force for a period of **five (5) years** subject to review and modification as mutually agreed upon.
- (2) Thereafter, if the **PARTIES** hereto wish to extend the terms of this Agreement, they shall do so by an express covenant in writing.
- (3) Notwithstanding anything in this Article, either **PARTY** may terminate this Agreement by notifying the other **PARTY** to its intention to terminate the Agreement by a notice in writing, at least 3 (three) months prior to its termination date. Termination shall be without penalty.
- (4) Such notice of termination does not affect any individual students who have already commenced or been accepted by either **PARTY**.

**Article 4**  
**FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS**

- (1) This Agreement will not give rise to any financial obligation by one **PARTY** to the other.
- (2) Each **PARTY** will bear its own costs and expenses in relation to this Agreement.

**Article 5**  
**DISPUTE RESOLUTION**

The **PARTIES** agree that all disputes arising pursuant to this Agreement shall be resolved by way of negotiations and discussion and with a view to an amicable settlement and mutual benefit of both **PARTIES**.

**Article 6**  
**FORCE MAJEURE**

Both **PARTIES** shall not be responsible for any delay or failure resulted in from events or circumstances beyond the reasonable control of either **PARTY** and in particular, any failure by either to carry out its obligations as set out in this Agreement.

**Article 7**  
**NOTICES AND CORRESPONDENCES**

- (1) Any communication under this Agreement will be written in English and delivered by registered mail to the address or sent to the electronic mail address or facsimile number of each **PARTY**.



