

Agreement of Cultural, Educational and Scientific Cooperation Between

Başkent University, Ankara, Türkiye

And

Universitas Negeri Malang (UM), Malang, Indonesia

Ref. Number: 11.6.8/UN32/KS/2025

In accordance with a mutual desire to promote further cooperation between their two institutions, Başkent University (BU), Ankara, Türkiye, and Universitas Negeri Malang (UM), Indonesia join in the following agreement on cultural, educational and research cooperation in all fields of medical and academic endeavor. Both BU and UM hereinafter shall collectively be referred to as "the PARTIES".

Article 1: Objective

Cooperation in specific areas may be designated by mutual consent and incorporated as addenda to this agreement upon signature by appropriate representatives of the institutions. Appropriate representatives may also specify the details of cooperation for any of identified fields in the form of addenda to this agreement upon signature.

Article 2: Scope of Activities

Within the fields of study to be mutually designated, both institutions agree to the following general forms of cooperation:

1. Joint research and educational activities.
2. Exchange of invitations to scholars (Faculty, research personnel and graduate students) for lectures, visits and sharing of experiences.
3. Exchange of invitations to scholars for participation in conferences, symposia and seminars.
4. Exchange of information in fields of interest to both parties.
5. Exchange of faculty, research personnel and graduate students for study and research.
6. Exchange of academic materials of mutual interest. This will include such items as scholarly publications, curriculum information, and pertinent research reports.

Both parties agree that all logistic and financial arrangements necessary to implement this agreement shall be negotiated separately for each individual collaboration.

Article 3: Further Agreements

Details of commitments relating to those activities described under Article II shall remain subject to later written agreements between the parties. Until such agreements are completed, neither party shall be under any formal commitment to provide any goods or services.

Article 4: Force Majeure

In the event of force majeure, including natural disasters, fires, security disturbances and other matters that result in the PARTIES being unable to carry out the obligations as referred to in ARTICLE 3, the losses suffered by the PARTIES shall be borne by the PARTIES and the PARTIES shall be released from claims for the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding including claims for losses arising from this force majeure.



The circumstances as referred to in paragraph (1) must have a direct causal relationship with the losses suffered by the PARTIES and be proven by a Certificate from an Authorized Official no later than 30 (thirty) working days from the occurrence of the event as referred to in previous paragraph.

Article 5: Contact and Correspondence

Every notice, request or any other communication required or permitted to be given pursuant to this MoU shall be in writing, in English, and delivered personally or sent by a registered or certified post via air mail or by courier or facsimile or email (which shall be acknowledged by other Party) to the Parties at the address, facsimile number, and email address as stated below:
