Today, **Monday, February 9**, the year **two thousand and twenty-six (9-02-2026)**, located at the **Faculty of Social Sciences State University of Malang**, the following signature:

- 1. Indah Wahyu Puji Utami, Ph.D.:** The Coordinator of the S1 History Education Study Program therefore legally represents and acts for and on behalf of the S1 History Education Study Program, Faculty of Social Sciences, State University of Malang, which is located at Jalan Semarang 5, Malang, hereinafter referred to as **the FIRST PARTY**.
- 2. Hafiz Shariff:** General Manager of the Malay Heritage Centre, Singapore, therefore, legally represents and acts for and on behalf of the Malay Heritage Centre, which is located in 85 Sultan Gate Singapore 198501, Singapore hereinafter referred to as **the SECOND PARTY**.

PARTY I and **PARTY II** hereinafter referred to collectively as **THE PARTIES**. The Parties hereby agree to jointly arrange an Implementation Agreement on the program Nusantara Arts Showcase Organized by **THE PARTIES** as regulated in the following articles.

Article 1

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

- (1) The purpose of this Cooperation Implementation Draft is as a basis for the implementation of cooperation prepared by **THE PARTIES** in accordance with the scope of this Implementation of Agreement.
- (2) The purpose of this Implementation of Agreement is to support each other's activities in the framework of cooperation related to the program of Nusantara Arts Showcase.

Article 2

SCOPE OF ACTIVITIES

- (1) The Scope of this agreement includes the program Nusantara Arts Showcase, wherein Indah Wahyu Puji Utami, Ph.D. has been assigned as the Person in Charge (indahwahyu.p.u@um.ac.id).
- (2) The implementation of cooperation for this agreement is carried out by **THE PARTIES**.
- (3) **THE PARTIES** shall monitor the implementation of the program Nusantara Arts Showcase not less than 1 (one) time in one period of activity.
- (4) **THE PARTIES** are to carry out organization of the showcase as stated in the attachment:
 - a) 3 school workshops
 - b) 3 production performances
 - c) 1 Launch Parade feature performance
 - d) 1 Kg Gelam Precinct programme

Article 3

FINANCING

- (1) The amount of funding for this Nusantara Arts Showcase activity is SGD 16,200 (Sixteen thousand and two hundred Singapore dollars), as specified in the approved budget attached to this Implementation of Agreement.
- (2) The funding shall be disbursed in 3 (three) batches, as follows:
 - a. The first batch shall be transferred by THE SECOND PARTY (or its authorized agent) to THE FIRST PARTY, through an official bank account or virtual account designated by Universitas Negeri Malang, prior to the Nusantara Arts Showcase activity. (SGD9,800)
 - b. The second batch shall be disbursed in cash/voucher during the visit of the team from Universitas Negeri Malang for the Nusantara Arts Showcase activity in Singapore. (SGD3,400)
 - c. The third batch shall be transferred by THE SECOND PARTY (or its authorized agent) to THE FIRST PARTY after the completion of the Nusantara Arts Showcase activity, through an official bank account or virtual account designated by Universitas Negeri Malang. (SGD3,000)
- (3) The cooperation funding provided under this Implementation of Agreement shall be used to support the implementation of the

Nusantara Arts Showcase activity, in accordance with the approved budget attached hereto and the applicable financial regulations.

Article 4 DURATION

This Implementation Agreement of cooperation is valid from 9/02/2026 until 9/02/2027.

Article 5 CLOSING

- (1) Any amendment to this Implementation Agreement shall only be made with the mutual approval of **THE PARTIES**.
- (2) This Implementation Agreement is deemed to be terminated if one **PARTY** or **THE PARTIES** fail to fulfill the provisions in this Implementation Agreement.
- (3) Particulars that are not / yet to be determined in this Implementation Agreement shall be addressed further by **THE PARTIES** on the basis of mutual discussion and agreement which shall be set forth in an Addendum, which is an integral part of this Implementation Agreement.
- (4) This document of Implementation Agreement is made and signed by **THE PARTIES** in 2 (two) copies, all of which shall constitute the equal legal force.

Article 6 Force Majeure

- (1) In the event of force majeure, including natural disasters, fires, security disturbances and other matters that result in the **PARTIES** being unable to carry out the obligations as referred to in ARTICLE 3, the losses suffered by the **PARTIES** shall be borne by the **PARTIES** and **the PARTIES** shall be released from claims for the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding including claims for losses arising from this force majeure.
- (2) The circumstances as referred to in paragraph (1) must have a direct causal relationship with the losses suffered by the **PARTIES** and be proven by a Certificate from an Authorized Official no later than 30 (thirty) working days from the occurrence of the event as referred to in paragraph (1).
