Box 4, 58 Moo 9, Km. 42, Paholyothin Highway, Klong Luang, Pathum Thani 12120, Thailand, hence referred to as **SECOND PARTY**.

FIRST PARTY and **SECOND PARTY**, hereinafter referred to collectively as **THE PARTIES**. CLOSING**


1. Any amendment or modification to this Implementation Agreement shall only be effected through mutual consent of **THE PARTIES** and documented in writing.






