



**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
INSTITUTIONAL COLLABORATION IN THE FIELD OF
PUBLICATION COLLABORATION FOR
THE 3RD MICROMEDHS INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE**

UNIVERSITAS NEGERI MALANG**

AND

THE PRODIA EDUCATION AND RESEARCH INSTITUTE (PERI)

Following the signing of the Memorandum of Agreement between Faculty of Medicine, Universitas Negeri Malang (UM), and The Prodia Education and Research Institute (PERI); Faculty of Medicine, Universitas Jember believe that mutual benefits can be derived by bridging their two institution achieving a closer relationship by linking their scholars, students, and personnel for institutional collaboration in the field of publication collaboration for the 3rd MICROMEDHS international conference. Both Institution shares the strong conviction that mutual understanding among people can be promoted through the establishment of academic links. Therefore, both Institution agree to enter into this Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) on Institutional Collaboration in the field of publication collaboration for the 3rd MICROMEDHS international conference.

Article I: Principle of Collaboration

The Parties agree to establish this collaboration based on the principles of mutual respect, equality, mutual benefit, and academic integrity. This collaboration aims to strengthen

institutional cooperation in supporting high-quality scientific publication arising from The 3rd MICROMEDHS International Conference.

Article II: Aim of Collaboration

Purpose of Collaboration

The purpose of this Memorandum of Agreement is to facilitate collaboration between the Faculty of Medicine, Universitas Negeri Malang and The Prodia Education and Research Institute (PERI) in the publication of selected scientific manuscripts presented at The 3rd MICROMEDHS International Conference in The Indonesian Biomedical Journal (InaBJ).

This collaboration is intended to:

- Support the dissemination of high-quality scientific research at the international level;
- Provide publication opportunities for selected conference papers in InaBJ;
- Enhance academic visibility and impact of both institutions.

Article III: Areas of Collaboration

Scope of Collaboration

The scope of this collaboration shall include:

1. Selection of manuscripts from The 3rd MICROMEDHS International Conference for potential publication in InaBJ;
2. Ensuring that selected manuscripts are clearly aligned with the scope of InaBJ, particularly in all fundamental and molecular aspects of basic medical sciences, emphasizing on providing the molecular studies of biomedical problems and molecular mechanisms.
3. Coordination between the conference scientific committee and InaBJ editorial team regarding manuscript handling and publication process.

Article IV: Implementation

It is understood and agreed that the implementation of this collaboration shall be carried out under the following terms:

1. Selected manuscripts from The 3rd MICROMEDHS International Conference will be considered for publication in InaBJ, subject to the journal's standards and policies;
2. For quality assurance, each manuscript shall undergo a peer-review process involving:
 - One reviewer recommended by the conference/scientific committee; and
 - One reviewer appointed by InaBJ;

3. Final decisions regarding acceptance, revision, or rejection of manuscripts remain under the authority of InaBJ in accordance with its editorial policies;
4. For the final submission and acceptance process, we will fully adhere to the editorial policies, standards, and review procedures of InaBJ to ensure the quality of the published articles;
5. We anticipate submitting approximately 1–3 selected manuscripts to InaBJ, depending on the outcome of the scientific evaluation and authors' confirmation;
6. We estimate that selected manuscripts from MICROMEDHS 2026 could be targeted for publication in the February, April, or June 2027 issue;
7. Any financial arrangements, including publication fees (if applicable), shall be communicated clearly and agreed upon separately.

Article V: Duration and Termination of the Agreement

- This Memorandum of Agreement shall become effective upon the date of signing by both Parties;
- This Agreement shall remain valid for the duration of The 3rd MICROMEDHS International Conference publication cycle, unless extended by mutual written agreement;
- This Agreement may be amended at any time by mutual written consent of both Parties;
- Either Party may terminate this Agreement by providing written notice to the other Party at least three (3) months prior to the intended termination date;
- Termination of this Agreement shall not affect any ongoing manuscript review or publication processes that have already been agreed upon prior to termination.

Article VI: Notices

Every notice, request or any other communication required or permitted to be given pursuant to this Agreement shall be in writing, in English and delivered personally or sent by registered or certified air mail or by courier or fax or email (which shall be acknowledged by the other Party) to the Parties at the addresses as stated below:

Dispute, controversy or claim arising out or relating to this Agreement, or the termination or invalidity thereto shall be solved amicably by both parties by discussion to reach consensus. Should consensus be not reached from the discussion, either party may take the dispute, controversy or claim to the Foreign Affairs in each country to find solution through diplomacy.

Article IX: Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Indonesia.
