This Implementation Agreement is entered into force on 24th February 2025 by and between:

- 1. Diana Tien Irafahmi, S.Pd., M.Ed., Ph.D.:** Head of the Bachelor Of Accounting Education Study Program; acting on behalf of Bachelor Of Accounting Education Study Program, Faculty of Economics and Business, Universitas Negeri Malang, located on Jalan Semarang 5, Malang, hereby referred to as **PARTY I**.
- 2. Dr. Usman Akbar.:** Assistant Professor at UCSI University, Malaysia, hom therefore legally represents and acts for and on behalf of UCSI University, whose address is at UCSI University, 1 Jalan UCSI, UCSI Heights (Taman Connaught), Cheras 56000, Kuala Lumpur, hereinafter referred to as **PARTY II**

PARTY I and **PARTY II** hereinafter referred to collectively as **THE PARTIES**. The Parties hereby agree to jointly arrange an Implementation Agreement on the teaching collaboration program Organized by **THE PARTIES** as regulated in the following articles.

Article 1 **PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES**

The Parties to this agreement wish to expand their activities for mutual benefit and in a spirit of research collaboration. The objective of this Implementation of Agreement is to develop further and carry out long-term collaborations as described under Article 2.

Article 2
SCOPE OF ACTIVITIES

The areas of collaboration on research activities covered under this Implementation of Agreement are as follows:

1. The scope of implementation of this Agreement includes the Research Collaboration Program on the topic "Accelerating Smart Green Tourism In Malang: Development of Easy Wallet As A Digital Transaction Wallet For Sustainable Tourism" conducted by Primasa Minerva Nagari, S.Pd., M.Pd., Ph.D and *et al* on 2025 with Dr. Usman Akbar from the UCSI University, Malaysia.
2. Any other areas of cooperation to be mutually agreed upon by the Parties.

Article 3
FUNDING

Funding for the implementation of teaching collaboration mentioned above will be discussed further by **THE PARTIES**. Once agreed, the funding document will be attached as an addendum to this letter.

Article 4
DURATION

This Implementation Agreement of cooperation is valid from 24th February 2025 until 10th November 2025.

Article 5
CLOSING

1. Any amendment to this Implementation Agreement shall only be made with the mutual approval of **THE PARTIES**.
2. This Implementation Agreement is deemed to be terminated if one **PARTY** or **THE PARTIES** fail to fulfill the provisions in this Implementation Agreement.
3. Particulars that are not / yet to be determined in this Implementation Agreement shall be addressed further by **THE PARTIES** on the basis of mutual discussion and agreement which shall be set forth in an Addendum, which is an integral part of this Implementation Agreement.
4. This document of Implementation Agreement is made and signed by **THE PARTIES** in 2 (two) copies, all of which shall constitute the equal legal force.

Article 6
FORCE MAJEURE

1. In the event of force majeure, including natural disasters, fires, security disturbances and other matters that result in the **PARTIES** being unable to carry out the obligations as referred to in ARTICLE 3, the losses suffered by the **PARTIES** shall be borne by the **PARTIES** and the **PARTIES** shall be released from claims for the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding including claims for losses arising from this force majeure.




