



MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

This Service Agreement is made and executed by and between:

FACULTY OF MEDICINE UNIVERSITAS NEGERI MALANG, with address at Street Semarang No. 5, Sumber Sari, Lowokwaru District, Malang City, East Java 65145, Indonesia, represented by its Dean Faculty of Medicine, Dr. dr. H. Moch. Yunus, M.Kes.

and

WORLD CITI COLLEGES (hereinafter referred to as "**WCC**"), an institution of higher learning with three campuses: **Quezon City Campus**, with the address 960 Aurora Blvd., Bagong Buhay, Quezon City, Metro Manila 1109, Philippines; **Antipolo Campus** with the address 156 M.L. Quezon Avenue, Antipolo City, Rizal, Philippines 1870; and **Guimba Campus** with the address Provincial Road, Saranay District, Guimba, Nueva Ecija, Philippines; represented by Director of International Affairs, Dr. Dick O. Eugenio.

Both organizations shall be referred to as the "Parties".

WHEREAS

Both parties intend to promote cultural educational and scholarly exchange through a technical interchange as educational partners. Now therefore, the Parties hereby agree to the following terms:

AGREEMENT

1. TERM

- A. This Memorandum of Agreement will be effective upon signature by each President for a period of **5 years**, at which time it will be reviewed for possible renewal for another 5-year period.
- B. Either Party may terminate this Memorandum of Agreement by serving a notice at least 30 days prior to the intended termination date. This notice of termination shall not prejudice the rights of students who have already commenced or been accepted by either Party at that time.

2. MUTUAL GOALS

- A. The Parties may jointly explore and implement any of the following programs but not limited to:

- i. **Faculty exchanges**

- Faculty of both parties mutually visit and conduct webinars, podcasts, or any other online platforms for various academic purposes;

- ii. **Student and faculty mobility**

- Faculty, staff, and students of both parties mutually visit for various academic purposes;

- iii. **Joint research and publication**

- Researchers of both parties arrange collaborative research and publications.

- iv. **Inter-cultural exposure**

- Students of both parties mutually visit to learn and experience cultural behavior.

- v. **International internship**

- Students of both parties mutually visit for hands-on experience in a student's major area of educational concentration or career interest.

- vi. **English language**

Students will take English programs as part of their academic curriculum or part of cultural immersion, ensuring flexibility to meet diverse learning needs and objectives.

- B. Before commencing any of these activities, the parties will discuss the details of implementing these individual programs and may thereafter enter into agreements that contain detailed steps and requirements based on the mutually agreed-upon objectives and outcomes.

3. RESPONSIBILITIES AND SERVICES

- A. This Memorandum of Agreement forms the framework for cooperation between the parties to identify shared goals, and to develop a genuine and mutually beneficial exchange process and research relationship.
- B. This Memorandum of Agreement is intended to set the general direction between the parties. It is not binding and does not impose any legal or financial obligations or liabilities on either party until the details of the programs have been discussed and agreed upon. Such Agreement on the specifics shall be the subject of a separate agreement.

4. WARRANTIES, REPRESENTATIONS and INDEMNIFICATION

Both parties warrant that in rendering the services under this Agreement, they shall comply with all laws, rules and regulations applicable while using reasonable skill and care in accordance with good industry practice in the performance of their obligations under this Agreement.

5. CONFIDENTIALITY

- A. Definition. For the purpose of this Agreement, Confidential Information means confidential commercial, business, financial, strategic, scientific, medical and technical information and data that either party receives from the other during the course of the performance of obligations under this Agreement.
- B. Obligations. Unless either party authorizes the other in writing, both parties shall use Confidential Information only for the purpose of this Agreement and disclose such Confidential Information to third parties only to the extent necessary for the performance of their duties and only after ensuring that such third parties are bound by obligations of confidentiality substantially similar to those in this Agreement.

6. ASSIGNMENT No rights, obligations or interests arising from this Agreement shall be transferred without the written consent of the other party.
