This Implementation Agreement is entered into force on 7 August, 2025 by and between:

- 1. Drs. Nur Hadi, M.Pd, M.Si.** : Head of Sociology Department, whom therefore legally represents and acts for and on behalf of the Department of Sociology, Faculty of Social Science, Universitas Negeri Malang, whose address is at Jalan Semarang 5, Malang, hereinafter referred to as Party I.
- 2. Dr. Illisriyani Ismail** : Co-Coordinator of Maritime Nusantara & Sustainability Policy Initiative, whom therefore legally represents and acts for and on behalf of the Study Program /Partner of the Centre for Policy Research (CPR), Universiti Sains Malaysia whose address is at 11800 USM, Pulau Pinang, Malaysia, hereinafter referred to as Party II.

PARTY I and **PARTY II** hereinafter referred to collectively as **THE PARTIES**. The Parties hereby agree to jointly arrange an Implementation Agreement on the **Maritime Nusantara & Sustainability Policy Initiative**. Organized by **THE PARTIES** as regulated in the following articles. The activity is in accordance with the provisions of Memorandum of Understanding signed by **THE PARTIES** on date/month/year.

Article 1
PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES

- (1) The purpose of this Implementation Agreement is to serve as the basis for the Implementation Agreement arranged by **THE PARTIES** in accordance with the scope of this Implementation Agreement Regulation.
- (2) The objective of this Implementation Agreement is to support the activities of **THE PARTIES** in relation to cooperation with regard to the **Maritime Nusantara & Sustainability Policy Initiative**.

Article 2
SCOPE OF ACTIVITIES

- (1) The Scope of this agreement includes the **Maritime Nusantara & Sustainability Policy Initiative**, wherein Joan Hesti Gita Purwasih, S.Pd., M.Si. has/have been assigned as the Person in Charge (joan.hesti.fis@um.ac.id).
- (2) The implementation of cooperation for this agreement is carried out by **CPR – Center for Policy Research, Universiti Sains Malaysia and Department of Sociology, Faculty of Social Science, Universitas Negeri Malang**.
- (3) **THE PARTIES** shall monitor the implementation of the program **Maritime Nusantara & Sustainability Policy Initiative**, not less than 2 (two) times in one period of activity.

Article 3
FUNDING

The amount of funding for this **Maritime Nusantara & Sustainability Policy Initiative** activity is charged to **PARTY 2**.

Article 4
DURATION

This Implementation Agreement of cooperation is valid from April 7 August, 2025 until 7 August, 2026.

Article 5
CLOSING

- (1) Any amendment to this Implementation Agreement shall only be made with the mutual approval of **THE PARTIES**.
- (2) This Implementation Agreement is deemed to be terminated if one **PARTY** or **THE PARTIES** fail to fulfill the provisions in this Implementation Agreement.
- (3) Particulars that are not / yet to be determined in this Implementation Agreement shall be addressed further by **THE PARTIES** on the basis of


- mutual discussion and agreement which shall be set forth in an Addendum, which is an integral part of this Implementation Agreement.
- (4) This document of Implementation Agreement is made and signed by **THE PARTIES** in 2 (two) copies, all of which shall constitute the equal legal force.

Article 6
Force Majeure

- (1) In the event of force majeure, including natural disasters, fires, security disturbances and other matters that result in the **PARTIES** being unable to carry out the obligations as referred to in ARTICLE 3, the losses suffered by the PARTIES shall be borne by the **PARTIES** and **the PARTIES** shall be released from claims for the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding including claims for losses arising from this force majeure.
- (2) The circumstances as referred to in paragraph (1) must have a direct causal relationship with the losses suffered by the **PARTIES** and be proven by a Certificate from an Authorized Official no later than 30 (thirty) working days from the occurrence of the event as referred to in paragraph (1).
