



COOPERATION MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
KYUNG-IN WOMEN'S UNIVERSITY (REPUBLIC OF KOREA)
AND
UNIVERSITAS NEGERI MALANG (INDONESIA)

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into force on [date] by and between:

1. **Universitas Negeri Malang (UM)**, a state university with legal entity (PTN-BH) in Indonesia, originally established in 1954 based on the Decree of the Ministry of Education and Culture of the Republic of Indonesia No. 33756/Kb dated August 4, 1954, having its principal address at Jalan Semarang No. 5, Malang 65145, East Java, Indonesia, hereinafter referred to as "Party 1";

and

2. **Kyung-In Women's University (KIWU)**, a private junior college in the Republic of Korea, established on March 2, 1992, and currently operating 26 departments, having its principal address at 63 Gyeyangsan-ro, Gyeyang-gu, Incheon, Republic of Korea, hereinafter referred to as "Party 2"

Both UM and and KIWU hereinafter shall collectively be referred to as "The Parties".

The Parties are seeking to establish collaborations under this MoU upon the terms as stated therein.

IT IS AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The purpose of this agreement is to develop academic and educational cooperation and to promote mutual understanding between the two universities.

2. Both universities agree to develop the following collaborative activities in academic areas of mutual interest, on a basis of equality and reciprocity with the cooperation of the Ministry of Education, Culture, Research and Technology of Indonesia:
 - A. Exchange of faculty and students
 - B. Conducting lectures and seminars
 - C. Organizing conferences and symposia
 - D. Exchange of academic information and materials
 - E. Promoting other academic cooperation as mutually agreed
 - F. Joint research with industries in both countries
 - G. Establishing a cooperation system for language and cultural exchange between the two countries
3. The development and implementation of specific activities based on this agreement will be separately negotiated and agreed between the faculties, schools or institutes, which carry out the specific projects. Both universities agree to carry out these activities in accordance with the laws and regulations of the respective countries after full consultation and approval.
4. Should any collaborative research activities under this agreement result in potential intellectual property, both universities shall seek an equitable and fair understanding regarding ownership and other property interests that may arise.
5. This agreement may be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both universities.
6. This agreement is valid for a period of 5 (five) years from the date of signing by the representatives of both universities and shall be automatically renewed unless otherwise agreed upon.
7. This agreement may, at any time during its period of validity, be terminated by either university upon prior written notice to the other, given no later than six months before the termination date.
8. Every notice, request or any other communication required or permitted to be given pursuant to this MoU shall be in writing, in English, and delivered personally or sent by a registered or certified post via air mail or by courier or facsimile or email (which shall be acknowledged by other Party) to the Parties at the address, facsimile number, and email address as stated below:
