This Implementation Agreement is entered into force on Wednesday, 13 May 2026 by and between:

1. Ir. Anie Yulistyorini, S.T., M.Sc., Ph.D: Head of Environmental Engineering Undergraduate Study Program, whom therefore legally represents and acts for and on behalf of the Environmental Engineering Undergraduate Study Program, Faculty of Engineering, Universitas Negeri Malang, whose address is at Jalan Semarang 5, Malang, hereinafter referred to as Party I.
2. Prof. Sheng-Jie You, Professor of the Department of Environmental Engineering, Chung Yuan Christian University (CYCU), Taiwan, who therefore legally represents and acts for and on behalf of the Department of Environmental Engineering, Chung Yuan Christian University (CYCU), whose address is at No. 200, Zhongbei Road, Zhongli District, Taoyuan City 320314, Taiwan, hereinafter referred to as PARTY II.

PARTY I and **PARTY II** hereinafter referred to collectively as **THE PARTIES**. The Parties hereby agree to jointly arrange an Implementation Agreement on the program Academic Engagement Organized by **THE PARTIES** as regulated in the following articles.

Article 1 PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES

- (1) The purpose of this Implementation Agreement is to establish cooperation between **THE PARTIES** in organizing academic activities related to environmental engineering, environmental technologies, and international academic collaboration.
- (2) The objectives of this Implementation Agreement are:

- a. To strengthen international academic cooperation between Universitas Negeri Malang and Chung Yuan Christian University (CYCU);
- b. To facilitate knowledge exchange in the field of emerging environmental pollutants and advanced environmental technologies;
- c. To support academic development through international guest lectures, collaborative discussions, and future research opportunities;
- d. To promote opportunities for student and lecturer academic mobility, research collaboration, and further study.

Article 2

SCOPE OF ACTIVITIES

- (1) The scope of this agreement includes the implementation of the program entitled: Academic Engagement including, but not limited to:
 - a. International guest lectures;
 - b. Academic discussions and scientific exchange;
 - c. Research collaboration opportunities;
 - d. Promotion of postgraduate and doctoral study opportunities;
 - e. Future academic and research networking activities.
- (2) The implementation of cooperation for this agreement is carried out by Ir. Anie Yulistyorini, S.T., M.Sc., Ph.D and Prof. Sheng-Jie You.
- (3) **THE PARTIES** shall maintain communication and coordination regarding the implementation and evaluation of activities under this agreement.

Article 3

FUNDING

The fee incurred from the activities born in this Implementation of Agreement is borne by the respective **PARTY** according to the applicable regulations and shall be specified in a separate specific written agreement.

Article 4

DURATION

This Implementation Agreement shall be valid from Wednesday, May 13, 2026 until Wednesday, May 12, 2027, and may be extended upon mutual written agreement by **THE PARTIES**.

Article 5

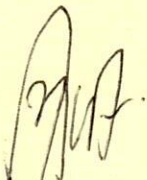
CLOSING

- (1) Any amendment to this Implementation Agreement shall only be made with the mutual approval of **THE PARTIES**.
- (2) This Implementation Agreement is deemed to be terminated if one **PARTY** or **THE PARTIES** fail to fulfill the provisions in this Implementation Agreement.
- (3) Particulars that are not / yet to be determined in this Implementation Agreement shall be addressed further by **THE PARTIES** on the basis of mutual discussion and agreement which shall be set forth in an Addendum, which is an integral part of this Implementation Agreement.
- (4) This document of Implementation Agreement is made and signed by **THE PARTIES** in 2 (two) copies, all of which shall constitute the equal legal force.

Article 6
Force Majeure

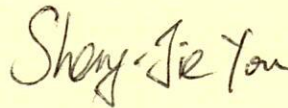
- (1) In the event of force majeure, including natural disasters, fires, security disturbances and other matters that result in the **PARTIES** being unable to carry out the obligations as referred to in ARTICLE 3, the losses suffered by the **PARTIES** shall be borne by the **PARTIES** and the **PARTIES** shall be released from claims for the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding including claims for losses arising from this force majeure.
- (2) The circumstances as referred to in paragraph (1) must have a direct causal relationship with the losses suffered by the **PARTIES** and be proven by a Certificate from an Authorized Official no later than 30 (thirty) working days from the occurrence of the event as referred to in paragraph (1).

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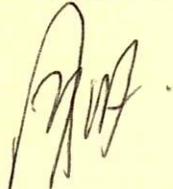
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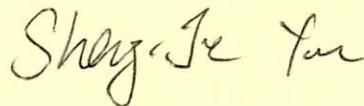
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
