



Implementation Agreement (IA)



BETWEEN
Mandarin Language
Education Study Program
AND
Confucius Institute

Article 1 **PURPOSE**

This agreement aims to establish cooperation between the Mandarin Language Education Study Program at Universitas Negeri Malang (hereinafter referred to as "Party 1") and Confucius Institute Director, Chen Wen Qiang, (hereinafter referred to as "Party 2"), in organizing the Mandarin Language Academic Lecturer Collaboration.

Article 2 **SCOPE**

This collaboration includes the following activities:

Party 2 will act as a reviewer in the selection process for Mandarin-speaking teachers.

Party 1 will organize the Mandarin learning and teaching process for students of the Mandarin Language Education Study Program.

Both parties will work together to ensure that this collaboration process runs well and smoothly.

Article 3 **OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTIES**

Obligations of Party 1:

- a. Party one agrees to accept 2 or 4 native speaking teachers to teach Mandarin at the first party for 1 year (2 semesters).
- b. Participate in discussions or meetings related to the selection process if necessary.
- c. Submit a final report to Party 2 regarding the teaching and learning activities that have been carried out.

Obligations of Party 2:

- a. Send native speaking lecturers to teach Mandarin at the first party for 1 year (2 semesters).
- b. The second party carries out the learning process in accordance with the curriculum and requirements that have been previously agreed upon.

Article 4 **FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS**

All costs associated with the teacher collaboration process will be borne by Party 2.

Any additional costs not covered in this agreement can be discussed and agreed upon together.

Article 5

DISPUTE RESOLUTION

Any disputes arising from the implementation of this agreement will be resolved amicably through mutual deliberation.

If a resolution cannot be reached through deliberation, the parties agree to resolve the dispute through mediation.

Article 6

FORCE MAJEURE

Neither party shall be held liable for failure to fulfill their obligations due to circumstances beyond their control, such as natural disasters, pandemics, riots, or other events categorized as force majeure. The affected party must notify the other party in writing within 7 (seven) working days of the occurrence of the force majeure event.

Article 7

MISCELLANEOUS

This agreement is effective as of the date of signature by both parties and remains valid until the completion of the selection process.

Any amendments or additions to this agreement must be made in writing and mutually agreed upon by both parties.

This agreement is drafted in two original copies in English, each having the same legal validity.

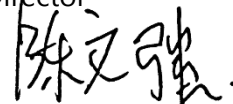
