



MEMORANDUM (LETTER) OF AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

**LEMBAGA PENELITIAN DAN PENGABDIAN KEPADA MASYARAKAT (LP2M)

**COMITATI CITTADINI INDIPENDENTI
EUROPA DEI CITTADINI
ASSOCIAZIONE EUROPEA DI VOLONTARIATO
DIRITTI UMANI SALUTE AMBIENTE**

This agreement is made and entered into by Lembaga Penelitian dan Pengabdian kepada Masyarakat (LP2M) Universitas Negeri Malang and Comitati Cittadini Indipendenti, The Health, Human Rights, and Environmental Volunteers Association in Italy, hereinafter referred to as "The Parties".

Desiring to strengthen research cooperation based on the principle of mutual benefit and to develop research projects from this cooperation by Lembaga Penelitian dan Pengabdian kepada Masyarakat (LP2M), Universitas Negeri Malang and Comitati Cittadini Indipendenti.

Under the prevailing laws and regulations in Indonesia, as well as the Indonesian government's procedures and policies on international research cooperation, The Parties have agreed as follows:

Article 1 Objective

The objective of the research cooperation under this LoA is to promote mutual research cooperation and develop research capabilities of two Parties in the research project entitled "Music Therapy Development for General Wellness as Support for Treatment of Mental Disorders and Improvement of Creative Abilities for Indonesian People". Dhara Alim Cendekia, S.Sn., M.Ds. of Faculty of Letter, Art and Design Department, Visual Communication Design Program, Universitas Negeri Malang will be the researcher representing his institution. Mr. Dott. Stefano Scippa, and independent researcher from Italy, will receive support from Comitati Cittadini Indipendenti for this research project.

Article 2 Scope of Activity

Joint research activities in the fields of music therapy will include the following:

- 1) The actual production of original music to be included in the application who is the final goal of the research as a form of music therapy available for the users' therapy to induce a state of deep relaxation and promote the treatment of mental disorders
- 2) Study and analysis of common musical elements (melodic, harmonic and rhythmic structures) than can be incorporated in music therapy
- 3) Investigation of the reaction of a sample of subjects to exposition to selected musical elements that can be applied to music therapy, collection and basic statistical analysis of data
- 4) Investigating characteristics and the elements of Indonesian traditional music that can be used in music therapy

Article 3
Scope of Activity

The activities to be conducted concerning the joint research program mentioned in Article 2 shall include:

- 1) Exchange of materials including publications and information
- 2) Joint scientific meetings for research
- 3) Other activities mutually agreed upon by Parties

Article 4
Contribution of Lembaga Penelitian dan Pengabdian Kepada Masyarakat (LP2M)
Universitas Negeri Malang

In accordance with the prevailing laws and regulations in Indonesia, and subject to the availability of resource, Lembaga Penelitian dan Pengabdian Kepada Masyarakat (LP2M), Universitas Negeri Malang shall:

- 1) Serve as the primary research site for the case study
- 2) Prepare a letter of acceptance written in Indonesia and addressed to Direktur Pengelolaan Kekayaan Intelektual selaku Sekertaris Tim Koordinasi Pemberian Izin Penelitian Asing (TKPIPA) Kementerian Riset, Teknologi, dan Pendidikan Tinggi
- 3) Assist in arranging the necessary permits including KITAS and Exit Permit Only for Mr. Dott. Stefano Scippa to enter and leave Indonesia whenever necessary
- 4) Assist to provide qualified researches, students, and technicians to assist in the implementation of activities under this LoA, especially from Pusat Bimbingan Konseling Karier dan Kompetensi Akademik (P2BK3A) and Art and Design Department.
- 5) Assist to provide access to the music laboratory of Universitas Negeri Malang
- 6) Assist to provide access to the hall for scientific meetings
- 7) Assist to provide access to library resources and internet service
- 8) Assist to provide access Universitas Negeri Malang's students for psychology therapy if they willing
- 9) Provide support for other activities agreed upon by both Parties

Article 5
Contribution of Comitati Cittadini Indipendenti

Comitati Cittadini Indipendenti shall:

- 1) Mr. Stefano Scippa will publish at least 3 scientific publication to be included in the accredited journal as a lead author about the progress and the result of the research
- 2) Willing to cooperate in other research by providing another researcher who wants to joint research with Universitas Negeri Malang's researchers
- 3) Provide scholarship information for faculty members or students of Universitas Negeri Malang who want to continue their studies or conduct research in Italy
- 4) Provide support for other activities agreed upon by both Parties

Article 6
Intellectual Property Rights, Results, and Publications

- 1) Any Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) brought by either Party for the implementation of activities under this LoA shall remain the property of that Party. However, that Party shall indemnify that the IPR has not resulted from the infringement of any third Party's legitimate rights. Further that Party shall be liable for any claim made by any third party on the ownership and legality of the use of IPR which is brought in by aforementioned Party for the implementation of joint research activities under this LoA
- 2) Any IPR resulting from joint research activities conducted under this LoA will be jointly owned by both Parties and both Parties shall be allowed to use such property for non-commercial purposes free of royalty. Should the intellectual property rights, data, or information resulting from research activities under this LoA be used for commercial purposes by one Party, the other Party shall be entitled to royalties obtained from the use of such property based on the principle of equitable contribution.
- 3) The Parties are entitled to use the results of their scientific cooperation for further educational and scientific purposes, including the right to publish the results. The proposed Party shall inform the other Party regarding publication and discuss the potential to draft the publication jointly, allowing for co-authorship. Publication in Indonesia will be the responsibility of Lembaga Penelitian dan Pengabdian Kepada Masyarakat (LP2M), Universitas Negeri Malang or a body designated by Lembaga Penelitian dan Pengabdian Kepada Masyarakat (LP2M), Universitas Negeri Malang, but the selection of material and the content of annotations will be decided in agreement with the researcher for as long as he remains alive. The researcher has the right to publish selections from the research results, or the results as a whole, outside Indonesia, in any medium. The selection of material and content of annotations will be decided in agreement with the researcher for as long as he remains alive and in consultation with Lembaga Penelitian dan Pengabdian Kepada Masyarakat (LP2M), Universitas Negeri Malang.
- 4) Termination of this LoA shall not affect the rights and/or obligation under this Article during 5 (five) years after such termination.

Article 7
Dispute Clause

Any dispute arising out of the interpretation or implementation of this LoA shall be settled amicably using prevailing Indonesian laws.

Article 8
Amendments, Duration, and Termination

- 1) Any amendment to this LoA can only be made in writing by the mutual consent of the Parties.
- 2) The LoA shall be effective from the date of its signing and be valid during the duration of the research.
- 3) The termination of this LoA shall not prejudice the completion of any ongoing programs that have been agreed upon by the Parties.
