



ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

Mahidol University (MU) has its origins in the establishment of Siriraj Hospital in 1888 by His Majesty King Chulalongkorn (Rama V), and the hospital's medical school is the oldest institution of higher learning in Thailand, granting its first medical degree in 1893. Later becoming the University of Medical Sciences in 1943, Mahidol University was renamed with great honor in 1969 by H.M. King Bhumibol Adulyadej, after his Royal Father, H.R.H Prince Mahidol of Songkla, who is widely known as the 'Father of Modern Medicine and Public Health in Thailand'. MU has since developed into one of the most prestigious universities in Thailand, internationally known and recognized for the high caliber of research and teaching by its faculty, and its outstanding achievements in teaching, research, international academic collaboration, and professional services. This diversified institution now offers top-quality programs in numerous social and cultural disciplines, including the most doctoral programs of any institution in Thailand, yet has maintained its traditional excellence in medicine and the sciences. MU has several campuses in Bangkok, Thailand's capital: a suburban campus, two older, inner-city campuses, and a downtown high-rise office site for the College of Management. The university also has provincial campuses in Kanchanaburi, Nakhon Sawan and Amnat Charoen provinces.

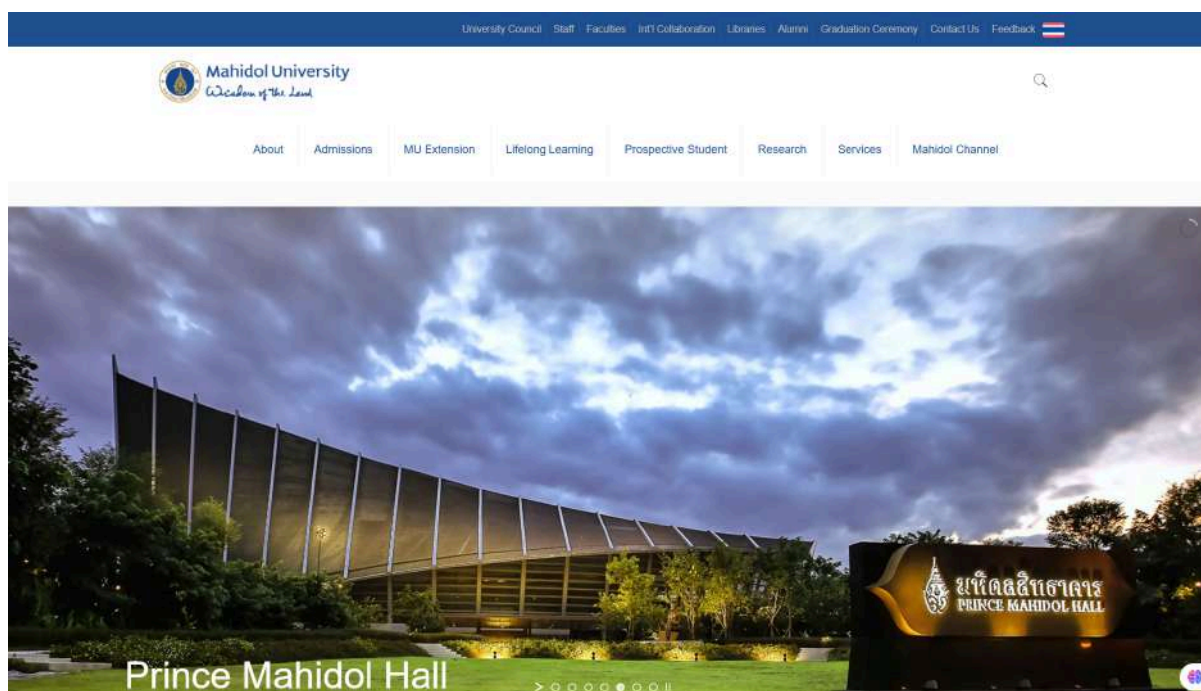

UNIVERSITY RANKINGS

Mahidol University is one of the top public universities in Nakhon Pathom, Thailand. It is ranked #368 in QS World University Rankings 2025. In the 2024 global university rankings, Mahidol University holds the 527th position out of 20,966 institutions worldwide, placing it in the top 2.6% of universities globally. This impressive standing highlights its academic reputation and influence on a global scale. Regionally, Mahidol ranks 123rd in Asia and is recognized as the 2nd best university in Thailand. The institution's strengths are evident in its research performance, with a research rank of 496, reflecting its dedication to academic and scientific contributions.
