

Memorandum of Understanding between Da-Yeh University, Taiwan and Universitas Negeri Malang, Indonesia

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into force on 20 May 2024 by and between Da-Yeh University and Universitas Negeri Malang in the recognition of the mutual benefits according to their academic communities. Da-Yeh University will hereinafter be referred to as "Party I", whereas Universitas Negeri Malang will hereinafter be referred to as "Party II". Both Da Yeh University and Universitas Negeri Malang will collectively be referred to as the "Parties".

- The purpose of this Agreement is to promote friendly relations through the development of academic collaboration between the two universities.
- 2. The collaboration shall be carried out, subject to availability of funds and the approval of each party, through such programmes or activities as:
 - (1) Joint research activities (including exchange of faculty members and research students).
 - (2) Joint teaching or supervision of students.
 - (3) Staging of joint seminars, conferences, and academic meetings.
 - (4) Special academic programmes.
 - (5) Education Abroad on the part of undergraduate and postgraduate students, including exchanges, internships, electives, and practicum.
 - (6) Exchange of academic materials and other information.
 - (7) Collaborative academic programmes which may involve cultural activities and field visits. These may be for groups or for individuals on Independent Guided Study Programmes.
 - (8) Joint collaborative Grant Proposals.
 - (9) Other programmes which are agreed by both Parties.
- Faculty members of both parties will be encouraged to consult with each other and to develop specific
 plans for collaboration in any of the ways mentioned in Article 2 above.
- 4. Recognizing that the implementation of any form of academic collaboration depends on the availability of financial support, both parties shall use their best endeavors to identify and gain access to suitable sources of funding to support the activities proposed in this Memorandum of Understanding.
- If disputes arise then with the consent of both parties such disputes shall be resolved through mutual
 consultation and/or negotiations between the Parties, without reference to any third party or international
 tribunal.
- Any amendment and/or modification of this Memorandum of Understanding will require written approval
 of the chief administrative officer of each party and shall be appended hereto.
- 7. This Memorandum of Understanding shall be valid for a period of five years and will become effective

from the latter date of signature by both Parties. After the initial five-year period, this Memorandum of Understanding shall be automatically renewed on a year-to-year basis or for a further period to be mutually agreed upon in writing by the parties.

8. Either party reserves the right to terminate this Memorandum of Understanding upon six months written notice to each other.
