



AGREEMENT FOR COOPERATION AND ACADEMIC EXCHANGE BETWEEN



NARESUAN UNIVERSITY (NU) AND

UNIVERSITAS NEGERI MALANG (UM)

Naresuan University and Universitas Negeri Malang, to develop cooperation and academic exchange in education and research between the two universities, have agreed as follows:

- 1. Based upon the principles of respect for each other's independence and of mutual benefit, the two institutions will carry out the following activities:
 - a) Joint research activities
 - b) Exchange of professors/research scholars/staff
 - c) Exchange of students
 - d) Exchange of scientific materials, publications and information
- Staff/students participating in any of the above mentioned activities must obtain health insurance from their home university. Recipients who do not have a health policy will not be accepted by the host university.
- 3. In order to carry out the above mentioned activities, a detailed plan is to be formed after consultation between the two universities.
- 4. The agreement may be revised or terminated upon mutual consultation and consent.
- 5. This agreement comes into force on the day when representatives of the two institutions affix their signatures and is valid for 5 years. This agreement is renewed automatically as long as neither party gives notice of termination to the other.
- 6. The notice of termination of the agreement needs to be given six months in advance.
