



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ON
ACADEMIC COLLABORATION AND PARTNERSHIP
BETWEEN**

UNIVERSITAS NEGERI MALANG, INDONESIA

AND

FINLAND UNIVERSITY, HELSINKI, FINLAND

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made to record the understanding between Universitas Negeri Malang, represented by Rector, Prof. Dr. AH. Rof'uddin residing in (Jalan Semarang 5, Malang 65145 Indonesia) (hereinafter referred to as "UM"), and Finland University, Mannerheimintie 20 B, 00100 Helsinki, Finland, Business ID2580777-5 (hereinafter referred to as "FinUni"), represented by its duly authorized representative Pasi Kaskinen, residing in Helsinki, Finland.

Whereas, UM and Finland University agreed to enter into the "Academic Collaboration and Education Partnership" (here in after referred collectively as "the Collaboration") for the advancement of academic, education development, and humanities and sciences to benefit the growth of Indonesia and Finland.

Hereby propose to collaborate with each other to promote the advancement of international understanding, dissemination of learning, and strengthening of cultural ties. They have entered into this MoU to create a foundation from which such collaboration may be developed.

1. MUTUAL INTEREST

The parties share a mutual intent to support and promote the spirit of this MoU by encouraging academic collaboration, including:

1. To make a significant contribution to the quality of the academic teaching skills
2. To develop teacher education curriculum and instructions and activities fostering the quality of teachers students
3. To look for possibilities in conducting research in cooperation
4. To enhance academic competencies of lecturers and staff
5. To boost the opportunities for external income of the two universities
6. To provide information about scholarships and study opportunities (e.g. at University's website)
7. Special projects to be determined

2. IMPLEMENTATION AND FUNDING

The implementation of each collaborative activities based on this MoU shall be separately negotiated and determined by both institutions and be conducted by way of separate written agreement. Those agreements will set out the Parties' various rights and obligations in respect of the those activities.

Both institutions agree that all specific financial agreements are to be negotiated separately for each component and are dependent on mutual interest and on the availability of funds from the public and private sectors, and/or international organizations.

3. COMMENCEMENT, RENEWAL, TERMINATION AND AMENDMENT

This Memorandum of Understanding is effective as of the date of execution by the appropriate officer of each signatory institution. This MoU shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years from the date of signing, with the understanding that it may be terminated by either party giving at least six months notice to the other party in writing. The MoU may be amended or extended by mutual consent in writing of the two parties.

4. LEGAL ISSUES

Nothing in this MoU will create a legal relationship between the Parties or be legally binding on them. This MoU is to affirm the intent of the Parties to work together in good faith in an attempt to progress the matters described this MoU.

Any dispute arising out of the interpretation or implementation of this MoU shall be settled amicably by consultation or negotiation among The Parties.
