



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

UNIVERSITY OF HYDERABAD, HYDERABAD, TELANGANA, INDIA

AND

UNIVERSITAS NEGERI MALANG, INDONESIA

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is drawn up and agreed upon to establish the cooperation between the University of Hyderabad (hereinafter referred to as UoH) located at Professor C.R. Rao Road, Gachibowli, Hyderabad — 500 046, Telangana, India and Universitas Negeri Malang (hereinafter referred to as State University of Malang UM) located at Jalan Semarang 5 Malang, 65145, East Java, Indonesia.

Description of both institutions:

The University of Hyderabad, a premier institution of Postgraduate teaching and research, was established by an Act of Parliament in 1974 as a Central University. The University has twelve Schools of Study—School of Mathematics and Statistics, School of Physics, School of Chemistry, School of Life Sciences, School of Humanities, School of Social Sciences, S.N. School of Arts and Communication, School of Management Studies, School of Engineering Sciences and Technology, School of Medical Sciences, School of Economics and School of Computer and Information Sciences.

Universitas Negeri Malang, comes from the College of Teacher's Education (PerguruanTinggiPendidikan Guru, or PTPG), which was inaugurated by the Minister of Education, Teaching and Culture, Prof. Mr. Muhammad Yamin, on October 18, 1954 based on the Decree No. 38742/Kab, September 1, 1954. Simultaneously, Prof. Sutan Adam Bakhtiar was commissioned as the first Rector of PTPG Malang.

The founding of another university in East Java, Universitas Airlangga (UNAIR) on November 10, 1954, brought about some important consequences to the status of PTPG Malang. PTPG Malang merged with UNAIR and became one of its four faculties. In due time, PTPG Malang became the Faculty of Teacher Training and Education of UNAIR (Fakultas Keguruan dan Ilmu Pendidikan, or FKIP). In 1963, FKIP UNAIR was converted into an independent instution, namely the Institute of Teacher Training and Education, which became better known as IKIP Malang (Institute of Teacher Training and Education).

The year 1999 marked yet another important change to the institution's status, as IKIP Malang obtained a greater mandate and was transformed into the Universitas Negeri Malang, or UM. UM is a leading university in East Java under the Ministry of Research, Technology and Higher Education, Republic of Indonesia which strives to enhance and strengthen its research and development and has taken various initiatives to complement its educational excellence and has entered into various collaborative arrangements with other parties to enhance networking.

Definition of Operative expressions:

The purpose of this **MoU** is to enable cooperation between **UoH** and **UM** for education, technology, research, and management to strengthen the capacity building of institution in the Asian region and to support the sustainable development in the global perspective.

Areas of collaboration:

The parties will promote and cooperate in:

- Academic Exchange in the broad areas of mutual interest from Faculties of Letters, Social Science, Economics, Education, Engineering, Mathematics and Science, etc.;
- ii. R&D collaborations in the above said areas;
- iii. Training and Teaching in the above areas;
- iv. Exchange of academic publications and educational materials;
- Assisting each other for the organization and/or participation in national and international symposia, conference, specialized exhibition and similar events taking place in the respective places/countries;
- vi. Joint research and project activities that are suitable for the faculty members in both institutions, with particular emphasis on internationally funded projects;
- vii. All other relevant activities of mutual interest to UoH and UM

4. Administration:

- 4.1 The Authorized signatories of both UoH and UM shall manage this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) and all endeavors that derive from it. They (or their designated representatives) will be responsible for developing and carrying out a joint plan and submission of regular reports on the implementation of this MoU. Any activity proposed that does not fit into the general terms of this MoU will be formally incorporated as an addendum to this MoU, provided the addendum is agreed to and signed by both parties.
- 4.2 For the purpose of facilitating the day-to-day implementation of this MoU, UoH and UM agree to have regular communications and correspondence.
- 4.3 This MoU shall be effective and comes into force upon signature of the authorized signatories of both the parties. It shall be subject to revision by written agreement between the two parties.
- 4.4 All the parties shall time and again keep the respective communities informed of this MoU to draw benefits from it and to contribute towards its implementation in spirit and substance.

5. Co-ordinators:

UoH and **UM** shall appoint "Coordinators" in their respective offices in Hyderabad and Indonesia who shall be responsible for coordinating all communications and directing the implementation of the **MoU**. For this purpose, the Coordinator for **UoH** is Director, Office of International Affairs and for **UM** is the Director, International Affairs. All notices to be given pursuant to this **MoU** shall be sent in writing to the following coordinators:

6. Duration:

The duration of this **MoU** shall be initially for a period of 3 (three) years which may be extended by mutual consultation and agreement.

7. Financial Provisions:

Sharing of expenditure shall be determined by the parties on a project-by-project basis and will be incorporated by reference as an addendum to this **MoU**.

8. Termination/ Amendment/Breakdown of MoU

- 8.1 Either party may terminate this MoU by written notification signed by the appropriate official of the institution initiating the notice. However, the other party must receive such notification at least three months advance notice in writing prior to the effective date of termination.
- 8.2. In the event of a breakdown due to disagreement etc., the expenditure incurred by the parties would remain on a 'As is Where is' condition. This would be decided on a project by project basis.
- 8.3 In the case of termination of the MoU, the students taking courses as part of an exchange at the partner institution should be allowed to continue till the end of that semester.

Undertaking by UoH and UM:

9.1 The parties hereto undertake to work closely and cooperate in the implementation of this MoU and to endeavor to resolve disputes arising between them in relation to this **MoU** by amicable means. Should this not be possible because of irreconcilable differences this **MoU** may be terminated by mutual consent of the two parties.

9.2 The parties to this MoU or their authorized representatives acknowledge having read and understood the MoU and agree to be bound by its terms and conditions.

10. Intellectual Property Rights:

Intellectual Property developed by the joint efforts would be the joint property of the Parties. Any financial benefits or otherwise arising would be shared proportionately by the parties in consonance with the efforts / inputs given by them.
