



**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

This Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) is made by and between :

1. Universitas Negeri Malang, Faculty of Social Sciences, addressed at Jl. Semarang 5 Malang 65145 Jawa Timur Indonesia (hereafter referred as **FIRST PARTY**);
and
2. Kodama Laboratory Department Of Social Studies, The Faculty Of Humanity, The Faculty of Environmental Engineering of The University of Kitakyushu, Japan, addressed at Kitakyushu Hibikino 1-1 Japan (hereafter referred as **SECOND PARTY**)

Faculty of Social Sciences, Universitas Negeri Malang and Kodama Laboratory Department Of Social Studies, The Faculty Of Humanity, The Faculty of Environmental Engineering of The University of Kitakyushu, Japan shall be jointly referred to as "the Parties" and severally as "the Party".

**ARTICLE I
PURPOSES/OBJECTIVES**

1. The Parties agree to cooperate in promoting academic collaboration and exchange between the two institutions with the joint purpose of improving mutual understanding between the two institutions and between Indonesia and Japan, and contributing to the advance of research and education.
2. The parties agree to conduct a research of the use of kamishibai (Japanese theater paper) media in environmental education learning with topics of hygiene in elementary schools.
3. The first party research team consists of Prof. Sugeng Utaya, Prof. Sumarmi, Ardyanto Tanjung, M.Pd
4. The second party research team consists of: Prof. Yayoi Kodama, Prof Hiroyuki Miyake, Prof. Toru Matsumoto and Indriyani Rachman, Ph.D.
5. The Parties specifically agree to promote :
 - a) Conducting research on important element supporting the Environmental Education learning, Life Style and Practices and the corporate in Kitakyushu, Japan
 - b) Evaluate and analysis the variables supporting the monitoring and controlling
 - c) Improving the environmental monitoring action for communities Publish paper(s) in the reputable journal(s)
 - d) Exchange of faculty and students related to the research and academic activities.

**ARTICLE II
IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROGRAMS AND FUNDING**

Details of the activities listed above and expenses resulting from this agreement will be negotiated between the Parties.

ARTICLE III

DURATION OF AGREEMENT

The agreement will be valid for a period of three years from the date of signing. The agreement can be renewed if both institutions agree to continue in written consent prior to the expiration date.

ARTICLE IV REVISION AND TERMINATION

The Parties must notify each other when they wish to revise or terminate the agreement. A period of one year notice is required before termination becomes effective. If any question on any part of the agreement arises, the Parties must consult each other to settle the issue.

ARTICLE V MISCELLANEOUS

1. Any amendments to the matters provided herein may be conducted only upon approval of the Parties as set out in the form of amendment or addendum, which shall constitute inseparable part hereof.
2. In case of any difference in the interpretation of the implementation of the provisions herein, the parties shall agree to settle the same in a mutual consensus in writing within a period of 6 (six) months calendar days.
3. The implementation of this MoA shall be subjected to the provisions and laws and regulations of the Republic of Indonesia.
