



## Agreement on Academic Collaboration Between

# COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING, DA YEH UNIVERSITY (大葉大學), CHANGHUA, TAIWAN

and

## FACULTY OF ENGINEERING UNIVERSITAS NEGERI MALANG, MALANG, INDONESIA

This Agreement on Academic Collaboration is made and signed on Tuesday, August, 20<sup>th</sup> 2019, between two parties, as followed:

1. Prof. Yuh-Wen Chen, Ph.D

Dean of College Engineering, representing Da Yeh University (大葉大學) having its address at No.168, University Rd., Dacun, Changhua 51591, Taiwan (R.O.C.), starting now referred to as FIRST PARTY.

2. Prof. Dr. Marji, M.Kes.

Engineering, representing Faculty of Engineering, Universitas Negeri Malang having its address at Jalan Semarang No. 5, Sumbersari, Lowokwaru, 65145 Jawa Timur, Indonesia, starting now referred to SECOND PARTY.

FIRST PARTY and SECOND PARTY starting now referred collectively as the PARTIES have agreed to sign the Memorandum of Agreement as the second step in cooperation by way of these requirements:

Whereas the PARTIES recognized that academic collaboration would be of mutual benefit and would provide strengths in research and education and their mutual interest in engaging themselves in academic cooperation. It is agreed that:

### **Objective**

- The primary purpose of this agreement is to provide specific cooperative activities of an academic and cultural nature may be implemented involving faculty and/or students from both PARTIES.
- 2. Recognizing the importance of mutual collaboration and the contributions to society made by institutions of higher education, both parties share a desire to develop mutually strengthening and enriching international educational and research experiences in Engineering field for both faculty and students by staging of collegial seminars, conference, guest lecture, and academic meetings hosting in each institutions.
- 3. Researchers in various disciplines from the Faculty of Engineering will be encouraged to develop contacts and propose collaborative projects and/or research. Each project proposal will be considered on its merits and availability of funds. The two PARTIES will seek internal and external sources for support of programs and exchanges, which may be developed as a result of this agreement.

#### Funding:

Both PARTIES agree to assist each other in obtaining external funding from outside sources.

#### Term:

- 1. This Memorandum of Agreement shall take effect when executed by both PARTIES and shall be for a term of three (3) years.
- 2. This Memorandum of Agreement shall be automatically renewed for successive three (3) year terms unless terminated as provided herein.
- 3. This Memorandum of Agreement may be terminated by either PARTY upon no less than ninety (90) days written notice to the other PARTY.

of invalidity to that shall be solved amicably by both parties by discussion to reach consensus. Should consensus be not reached from the discussion, either party may take the dispute, controversy or claim to the Foreign Affairs in each country to find a solution through diplomacy.

#### General:

 All research and other collaborative activities conducted under this agreement shall be conducted by the laws and regulations appropriate to each institution and all applicable government and local laws, rules, and regulations.
