



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

**Faculty of Engineering, State University of Malang
Malang, Indonesia**

&

**World Institute for Engineering and Technology Education (WIETE)
Melbourne, Australia**

The Faculty of Engineering at the State University of Malang, Malang, Indonesia (hereinafter called "FE-UM") and the World Institute for Engineering and Technology Education (hereinafter called "WIETE") mutually agree to pursue the mission, aims and objectives of WIETE; desire to join forces in promoting and developing engineering and technology education globally and wish to express their mutual understanding in this respect.

ARTICLE 1

The paramount objective of this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is to develop a working, supportive and friendly relationship/partnership between the FE-UM and WIETE for the benefit of the two parties involved, as well as the entire global community of engineering and technology education.

ARTICLE 2

Subject to the availability of funds, both parties intend to pursue jointly a wide range of activities, including the following:

- 2.1 Carry out research and development projects in engineering and technology education;
- 2.2 Exchange staff in order to facilitate cooperation;
- 2.3 Organise jointly specific courses, seminars, international conferences and meetings;
- 2.4 Publish books, conference proceedings, periodicals, journals, etc;
- 2.5 Cooperate in postgraduate activities and programmes;
- 2.6 Conduct professional consultancies;
- 2.7 Develop and promote regional and topical groupings and networks;

ARTICLE 3

Both parties wish to acknowledge and record the potential benefits that will be received by the Partner Institution (FE-UM), which include the following:

- 3.1 Inclusion and presentation of partner institution's name and logo in selected WIETE media, promotional material and publications;
- 3.2 Representation on WIETE's International Academic Advisory Committee (WIETE-IAAC);
- 3.3 Access to, and the participation in, the activities of the WIETE and its global network;
- 3.4 Access to all WIETE published materials in all media;
- 3.5 The right to establish a WIETE-affiliated centre of excellence;
- 3.6 Cooperation in seeking funds from local and international funding bodies and agencies to support joint activities and projects.

ARTICLE 4

- 4.1 This MoU is intended to establish and facilitate a collaborative relationship between the two parties concerned.
- 4.2 This MoU is effective as of the date of signing by the appropriate officer of each organisation and shall continue in effect for one year, and can be extended by mutual consent of both organisations.
- 4.3 Under this MoU, FE-UM is confirmed to be a full Member/Partner Institution of WIETE for which the FE-UM will pay an annual membership fee as determined for WIETE Partner Institutions and will receive the partnership benefits as listed in ARTICLE 3.
- 4.4 FE-UM may wish to nominate one of its members as its representative in charge of the co-operative programmes developed under this agreement.
- 4.5 Both parties have the same view and agree that neither WIETE nor FE-UM will be held responsible for any legal and other liability whatsoever as the MoU is not intended to create legal rights between the two parties. Therefore, neither party would require any insurance against any misfortune arising from this MoU.
- 4.6 Neither party will accept any responsibility whatsoever for any dealings with a third party.
- 4.7 Both parties reserve the right to terminate the MoU giving due notification of one month.

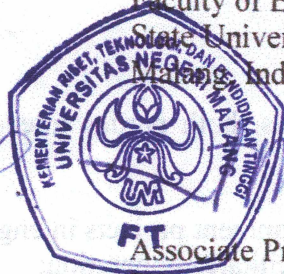
