



Agreement on Academic Exchange between

Faculty of Engineering, Universitas Negeri Malang, Indonesia

College of Mechanical and Electrical Engineering National Taipei University of Technology, Taiwan

Faculty of Engineering, The State University of Malang ("UM"), Malang, Indonesia and College of Mechanical and Electrical Engineering, National Taipei University of Technology, Taiwan (Taipei Tech) make this Agreement on Academic Exchange Between themselves ("Agreement") with the objective of promoting academic exchange through educational and research collaboration between two Institutes, as follows:

- 1. Parties and Agreement Intent. UM and Taipei Tech desire to establish certain exchange programs beneficial to the respective educational institutions and to promote the development of joint studies, research and training activities, and other educational programs of mutual interest, and will make an effort to promote and develop cooperation in the following activities within the guidelines of equal benefit and mutual respect.
 - (1) Exchange of faculty members
 - (2) Exchange of graduate students
 - (3) Exchange of academic materials and publications
 - (4) Conducting joint research project and organizing symposia
- 2. Specific Programs. Regarding the implementation of the above-mentioned activities, the two Institutes will consult prior to the event or signing any additional written documents. UM and Taipei Tech expect written documents on specific program agreements will be exchanged and signed prior to the start of the activities listed.

- 3. Term and Renewal. This Agreement is valid for five (5) years from the date of signing by both Institutes and shall continue in effect for an initial period ending five (5) years after the effective date. After five (5) years from the date of signing by both Institutes, this Agreement shall terminate unless the parties agree in writing to continue.
- 4. Intellectual Property. Should any faculty collaboration result in any potential for intellectual property, UM and Taipei Tech shall immediately meet through designated representatives and seek an equitable and fair understanding as to ownership and other property interests that may arise. Any such discussions shall at all times strive to preserve a harmonious and continuing relationship between the Universities.
- 5. Effect of Execution; Copies. This Agreement is executed in English, of which shall be deemed as originals. The English language version controls to be extent of any conflict. Each of UM and Taipei Tech will keep one of them.
