AGREEMENT ON ACADEMIC COOPERATION AND EXCHANGE BETWEEN

STATE UNIVERSITY OF MALANG INDONESIA

AND

SAGA UNIVERSITY, JAPAN

The Rector of State University of Malang, Indonesia and the President of Saga University, Japan hereby agree to encourage and promote academic cooperation and exchange between their two respective universities. The scope and procedural details of the Agreement are delineated below.

- 1. The two universities agree to encourage and promote the following academic and scholarly activities:
 - (a) Exchange of faculty and staff members
 - (b) Exchange of students
 - (c) Exchange of publications and relevant academic and scholarly information
 - (e) Other mes deemed appropriate by mutual consent
- Financial arrangements and stipulations concerning, e.g., the exchange of students, faculty
 and staff members, are to be specifically detailed in separate addenda.
- 3. Modificatio and/or amendments to this Agreement can be executed by mutual consent.
- 4. Should eit in university wish to terminate this Agreement, written notice should be given three month in advance of the desired termination date.
- 5. Only the Englis version of this Agreement has binding effect.
- 6. This Agreemen, will enter into effect from the date signed by the duly designated officials of the respective universities. The effective period is 5 years, and it will be extended so long as neither party expresses a desire to terminate or modify this Agreement.

ADDENDUM TO THE AGREEMENT ON ACADEMIC COOPERATION AND EXCHANGE BETWEEN

State University of Malang, Indonesia and Saga University, Japan can send their students to the counterpart university, within the valid period of the Agreement, in accordance with the following conditions:

- 1. Students are sent with the status of special auditor or special research student.
- 2. Length of stay shall not exceed 12 months.
- 3. Number of exchanged students shall not exceed three.
- 4. Examination fees, entrance fees and tuition fees are mutually exempted.
- 5. Academic credits obtained at the host university are accredited according to the rules of the home university.
- 6. Should this Agreement be terminated, students already participating in the exchange will be allowed to complete their studies at the host university.
