



**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
FOR STUDENT MOBILITY PROGRAM
BETWEEN
FACULTY OF SCIENCE AND GRADUATE
SCHOOL OF MANAGEMENT AND INNOVATION
KING MONGKUT'S UNIVERSITY OF
TECHNOLOGY THONBURI
AND
THE GRADUATE SCHOOL
UNIVERSITAS NEGERI MALANG**



PREAMBLE

This Agreement is made at King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi 126 Pracha Uthit Road, Bang Mod, Thung Kru, Bangkok, Thailand, on March 27, 2017 between the Faculty of Science and Graduate School of Management and Innovation of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi as one party with the Graduate School of Universitas Negeri Malang (State University of Malang) as another party. Both the parties have agreed to establish this Memorandum of Agreement for Student Mobility Program to further strengthen the co-operation between the colleges, faculty and school of the two universities. Both the parties have agreed upon the following:

I. AGREEMENT

Both the parties have agreed to arrange activities, education, and short training program to enhance the academic skills of students in order to strengthen the relationship between the international networks of higher education and to create prototype for international students who come to enroll during the summer semester.

II. DURATION OF OPERATION

This agreement shall take effect immediately on the date of the contract when signed for the activities within the year 2017. The duration of the program is 4 weeks between May to July, 2017.

III. NUMBER OF STUDENTS AND FIELD OF STUDY

State University of Malang will send ten students of the Post-graduate Geography Education Department to attend three courses at the Faculty of Science, King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi. The latter will provide 3 courses:

- (a) Application of Geographical Information System and Planning
- (b) Integrative Geographical and Geophysical Modeling by PYTHON
- (c) Strategic Management and Business Control

The activities will include lectures, discussions and field trips.

IV. RECORD AND CREDITS

At the end of the course the Faculty of Science, King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi will award each student a Certificate of Achievement the grade of each subject attended. The certificates also show the courses the students have taken and the grades they earn. The students will be evaluated based upon the grading system of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi which is equivalent to State University of Malang as the following table.

V. FINANCIAL

The Amount of Payment

State University of Malang is to make payment for the program and need not be responsible for any costs arising from the purchase or acquisition of other things, including any cost arising from the exercise of any copyright, patent or other intellectual property for this program. The payment for the program fee of 691,960 THB (six hundred and ninety-one thousand nine hundred and sixty Thai Baht) is to deliver in two installments (The event is to be held in the year 2017 only) as follows:

For the first installment, the amount of 420,000 THB (four hundred and twenty thousand Thai Baht) is to be paid prior to the arrival of students. For the second installment, the amount of 271, 960 THB (two hundred and seventy-one thousand nine hundred and sixty Thai Baht) is to be paid when deliver the program within the specified period. (The event is to be held in the year 2017 only), and the State University of Malang has reviewed and accepted that the assigned project is correctly and fully completed.

Payment Method

State University of Malang is to make payment for the program as shown in Table No.2 by money transfer to bank account “King Mongkut’s University of Technology Thonburi” No. 330-1-16927-2 Bank of Ayudhya Public Company Limited in two installments without deduction of withholding tax because a state agency is exempted from income tax but other taxes and fees will be charged (if any) on the date the State University of Malang has reviewed and accepted that the assigned project is correctly and fully completed.

Note: All expenses can be shared upon the proper situation as well as be paid at the reasonable and real cost. The program fee charged to Universitas Negeri Malang students at US\$ 1,977.36/person. Exchange rate of Bank of Thailand as of 17 February 2017 : 34.994 Baht/US Dollar (Weighted-Average Interbank Exchange Rate).

X. DOCUMENTS AND CERTIFICATIONS

Each student is responsible for obtaining a visa and other related documents required for study at the host institution. The host institution shall provide incoming students with any university certifications required to obtain a student visa for the full period of the program.

XI. TERMS

This agreement shall take effect when signed by legal representatives of both universities and be valid for a period of 6 months. Any students who have commenced at either university at the date of termination may complete their courses of study.


