



## LETTER OF INTENT BETWEEN UNIVERSITAS NEGERI MALANG AND UNIVERSITI KEBANGSAAN MALAYSIA

In order to promote the mutual interests between the Parties, Universitas Negeri Malang and Universiti Malaya, a university established under the laws of Malaysia through its Faculty of Education hereby agree to exercise their best efforts to develop the following forms of cooperation:

- 1. UM Recognising the Parties' desire to establish a joint co-operation in the areas of education and training on the basis of reciprocity and mutual benefit for both Parties, the Parties hereby agree to seek to promote the following:
  - (a) Guest Lecturers and co-Teaching / Team Teaching
  - (b) Research Collaboration with the Matching Grant
  - (c) Joint Publication in Journal (Scopus/ WoS)
  - (d) Joint Conference
- 2. The terms of co-operation for each specific area of co-operation implemented under this Letter of Intent (LOI) shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both Parties prior to its initiation and shall form the subject of separate addendum to be subsequently entered into between the Parties.
- 3. The Parties hereby agree that they are not bound exclusively by this LOI and shall be at liberty to enter into any separate agreements or arrangements with any third party without reference to the other Party.
- 4. Both Parties will appoint a coordinator from each party for the development and management of the above activities.
