LETTER OF INTENT BETWEEN UNIVERSITI MALAYA AND

UNIVERSITAS NEGERI MALANG

In order to promote the mutual interests between the Parties, Universiti Malaya, a university established under the laws of Malaysia through its Faculty of Education and Faculty of Psychology hereby agree to exercise their best efforts to develop the following forms of cooperation:

- 1. UM Recognising the Parties' desire to establish a joint co-operation in the areas of education and training on the basis of reciprocity and mutual benefit for both Parties, the Parties hereby agree to seek to promote the following:
 - (a) The Visiting Lecturer shall be held for the purpose to increase the students' skills and knowledge in the course of 'Principles and Practices of Pedagogy' in the Department of Psychology, Faculty of Psychology, Universitas Negeri Malang
 - (b) Lecture will be led by the lecturer from Faculty of Psychology in Educational Psychology in the course of 'Comprehensive Learning Method' which is to be held in the University of Malaya
- 2. The terms of co-operation for each specific area of co-operation implemented under this Letter of Intent (LOI) shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both Parties prior to its initiation and shall form the subject of separate addendum to be subsequently entered into between the Parties.
- 3. The Parties hereby agree that they are not bound exclusively by this LOI and shall be at liberty to enter into any separate agreements or arrangements with any third party without reference to the other Party.
- 4. Both Parties will appoint a coordinator from each party for the development and management of the above activities.
