

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT



Between

THE CHEMICAL SOCIETY OF THAILAND UNDER THE PATRONAGE OF HER ROYAL HIGHNESS PRINCESS CHULABHORN MAHIDOL

and

FACULTY OF MATHEMATICS AND NATURAL SCIENCES, UNIVERSITAS NEGERI MALANG (UM)

The Chemical Society of Thailand and Faculty of Mathematics and Natural Sciences, Universitas Negeri Malang (UM), Indonesia believe that mutual benefits can be derived by bridging their two sides, achieving a closer relationship by linking their personnel. Both sides share the strong conviction that mutual understanding among people can be promoted through the establishment of academic links. Therefore, both sides agree to enter into this Memorandum of Agreement (MoA).

Article I: Principle of Collaboration

The Chemical Society of Thailand and Faculty of Mathematics and Natural Sciences, UM agree to develop their academic links under the principle of mutual understanding, mutual benefits, common interests, and mutually complementary activities.

Article II: Areas of Collaboration

Area of collaboration includes organizing Small-Scale Chemistry Workshop offered by The Chemical Society of Thailand and Faculty of Mathematics and Natural Sciences, UM.

Article III: Aim of Collaboration

- (1) To conduct teacher trainings
- (2) To develop and encourage joint research
- (3) To develop and encourage joint publications
- (4) To hold joint academic activities, such as workshop, conferences, training

- (5) To facilitate and encourage staff and students exchanges between Faculty of Mathematics and Natural Sciences, Universitas Negeri Malang and member universities of the Chemical Societies of Thailand
- (6) To assist each other in obtaining external funding from outside sources.

Article IV: Implementation

It is understood and agreed that:

- (1) Proposals for collaborative projects under this MoA will be submitted through the Chief Executive Officer of the two sides, and it is recommended that reports should be submitted to each Chief Executive Officer at the completion of each project.
- (2) Student mobilization will apply to undergraduate and graduate/post graduate students from the Faculty of Mathematics and Natural Sciences, UM, and member universities of the Chemical Society of Thailand. After the exchange student's completion, the host institution will send academic transcripts of the student's work to the appropriate officer of the home institution.
- (3) Financial arrangements for collaborative research, seminars, workshops, conference, and other such activities will be negotiated separately and will be subject to the availability of funds.

Article V: Duration and Termination of the Agreement

- (1) This MoA is effective as of the date of signature by the Chief Executive officer of the two sides for three (3) years.
- (2) This MoA may be amended at any time as indicated by written mutual consent.
- (3) This MoA may be terminated by either side by the provision of a written notice of termination not less than six months prior to the desired termination date. However, both sides agree that at that time all continuing obligation to participants, staff, funding bodies or other entities are met in full subsequent to the notice of termination.

Article VI: Confidentiality

The Parties agree and undertake to keep confidential at all times any information or data that may be exchanged, acquired or shared in connection with any programme or activity conducted pursuant to this agreement and where the same is already in public domain.

Article VII: Dispute Resolution

Dispute, controversy or claim arising out or relating to this Agreement, or the termination of invalidity thereto shall be solved amicably by both parties, failing which either party may take the dispute, controversy or claim to any competent court of law in Thailand or Indonesia.

Article VIII: Notices

Every notice, request or any other communication required or permitted to be given pursuant to this Agreement shall be in writing, in English, and delivered personally or sent by registered or certified air mail or by courier or fax (which shall be acknowledged by the other Party) to the Parties at the addresses as stated below:
